Philosophy and process

The manager applies a strategic asset allocation framework to determine the ideal portfolio allocations intended to achieve the return objective over the investment time horizon, with a preference given for lower volatility outcomes. The manager's portfolios typically consist of a mix of income and growth assets and are typically diversified across asset classes, investment managers and security types. Asset allocation and security selection is actively managed, with a strong focus on risk, and continually reviewed by the manager to adapt to changes in market conditions. The manager believes that markets are never fully efficient and aims to maximise returns on an after fee basis for investors by balancing expected returns, risks and costs.
