The Significant Investor Visa was introduced by the Australian Government in November 2012 as a new visa pathway for people coming to Australia - part of the Business Innovation and Investment visa category. Among other eligibility requirements applications must have a minimum of \$5 million Australian dollars to invest into complying investments to be held for a minimum of four years.
