Investment Objective

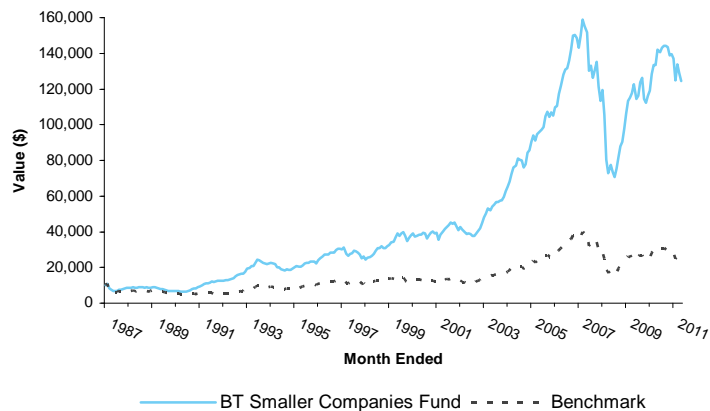
The Fund aims to provide a return (before fees, costs and taxes) that exceeds the S&P/ASX Small Ordinaries Accumulation Index over the medium to long term.

The Fund is actively managed and invests in companies outside the top 100 listed on the Australian Stock Exchange and their equivalent on the New Zealand Stock Exchange that we believe are trading below their assessed valuation, and which we expect to grow their profits quickly.

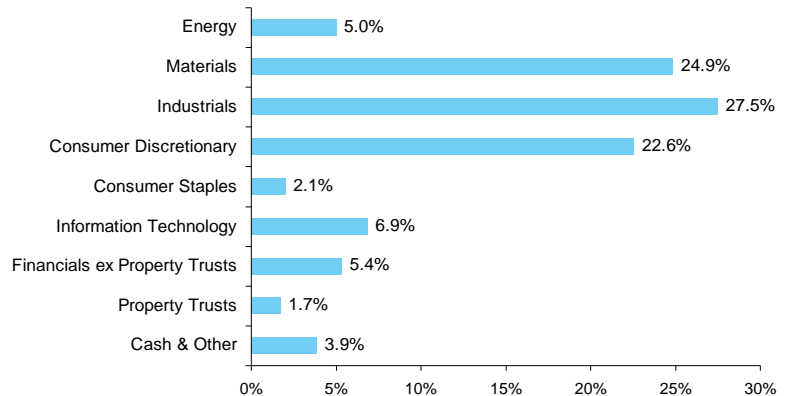

Progress of the Portfolio Investment

Fund performance

The fund managed to post a small positive return in what was a negative quarter for the market. The strongest contributor to fund outperformance was our underweight position in Medusa Mining, which reflects our preference for production- focused copper and gold stocks rather than explorers. Detracting from performance was our overweight position in Collins Food. In November the company informed the market of lower first half net profit after-tax (NPAT) and no dividend, citing very poor consumer sentiment.

Market Outlook

Small caps underperformed the broader ASX300 Accumulation Index, which eked out a positive return of 2%. Confidence was sapped by enduring concerns from Europe and fresh ones from China, meaning that both November and December were sharply lower. However, there are a lot of things keeping us upbeat about the prospects for the fund. Our portfolio is built around quality names with strong positioning and pricing power, and we are selectively investing in a number of stocks where the sell-off has been overdone.

Other Features
