Closure of BT Link phone service

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This notice dated 1 February 2017, updates information contained in the BT Investment Funds Product Disclosure Statement (PDS) dated 1 July 2013, Supplementary PDS (SPDS) dated 23 September 2013, Second Supplementary PDS (Second SPDS) dated 1 July 2014 and Third Supplementary PDS (Third SPDS) dated 23 September 2016 (collectively referred to as the PDS) jointly issued by BT Funds Management Limited ABN 63 002 916 458, AFSL 233724, BT Funds Management No. 2 Limited ABN 22 000 727 659, AFSL 233720 and Westpac Financial Services Limited ABN 20 000 241 127, AFSL 233716. It should be read together with the PDS which is available at bt.com.au.

Closure of BT Link phone service

From 28 February 2017 BT's automated telephone service, BT Link, will close.

BT has been monitoring the usage of BT Link, and the number of customers using the service has substantially declined in recent years. As BT Link uses older unsupported software and is expensive to maintain, it has been deemed in the best interests of our customers to decommission the service.

BT's other electronic transaction facility, BT Online, remains active and is unaffected by these changes.
