This notice updates information contained in the BT Classic Investment Funds Product Disclosure Statement (PDS) dated 1 July 2013 and the Supplementary Product Disclosure Statement (SPDS) dated 23 September 2016 (collectively referred to as the PDS). Closure of BT Link

From 28 February 2017 BT's automated telephone service, BT Link, will close.

BT has been monitoring the usage of BT Link, and the number of customers using the service has substantially declined in recent years. As BT Link uses older unsupported software and is expensive to maintain, it has been deemed in the best interests of our customers to decommission the service.

BT's other electronic transaction facility, BT Online, remains active and is unaffected by these changes.
