## Changes to the BT Investment Funds buy-sell spreads

21 December 2020

This Update, dated 21 December 2020, updates information contained in the BT Investment Funds Product Disclosure Statement (PDS) dated 30 September 2017 jointly issued by BT Funds Management Limited ABN 63 002 916 458, AFSL 233724, BT Funds Management No. 2 Limited ABN 22 000 727 659, AFSL 233720 and Westpac Financial Services Limited ABN 20 000 241 127, AFSL 233716. It should be read together with the PDS which is available at [bt.com.au](http://bt.com.au).

The information in the PDS is updated for the changes set out below.

### Changes to the BT Investment Funds buy-sell spreads

The underlying fund managers for **BlackRock Scientific Diversified Growth Fund**, **Perpetual Conservative Growth Fund**, **Platinum International Fund**, **Schroder Absolute Return Income Fund** and **UBS Diversified Fixed Income Fund** have changed their buy-sell spreads.

From 21 December 2020, the buy-sell spread for these funds will decrease. This is summarised in the table below:

### Future changes to buy-sell spreads

The applicable buy-sell spread may vary from time to time. Prior notice will not ordinarily be provided. In times of market volatility, such as the current COVID-19 pandemic, we expect the buy-sell spreads to regularly change and significant increases may occur.
